The bill includes an appropriation clause that adds a provision appropriating a total of \$259,251 cash funds from the Telecommunications Utility Fund to the Department of Regulatory Agencies for FY 2021-22. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the department will require an additional 3.0 FTE.
