Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides a total of \$75,000,000 cash funds, which originate as General Fund transferred into three different cash funds, described below:

• \$35,000,000 from the Digital Inclusion Grant Program Fund to the Office of Information

- \$35,000,000 from the Broadband Stimulus Account of the Broadband Administrative Fund to the Department of Regulatory Agencies; and
- \$5,000,000 from the Interconnectivity Grant Program Fund to the Department of Local Affairs.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2021-22 budget package the \$75,000,000 General Fund revenue decrease that would result from the passage of this bill. Specifically, the JBC package includes a place holder of \$800.0 million General Fund for those bills that are part of the "State Stimulus Package", and this bill is part of that package.
