Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$15,419 General Fund to the Department of Education for FY 2021-22. Additionally, the amendment

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reappropriates \$15,419 to the Department of Law based on the assumption that the Department of Law will require an additional 0.1 FTE.

Points to Consider*General Fund Impact*

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) is developing a budget package for FY 2021-22. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$15,419 for FY 2021-22, reducing the General Fund available for other FY 2021-22 appropriations by this amount.
