*Future Fiscal Impact*

Although this bill would not require a General Fund appropriation for FY 2021-22, it is projected to require General Fund appropriations of \$220,177 in FY 2022-23 and \$134,591 in FY 2023-24, and reduce General Fund revenues by an estimated \$110,592 in FY 2022-23 and future years, reducing the amount of General Fund available for other purposes.
