**Bill Topic:** REVISOR'S BILL

**Summary of Fiscal Impact:** **No fiscal impact.** The bill amends or repeals obsolete, unclear, or conflicting laws. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact on state or local government as it makes only technical changes.

**Appropriation Summary:** No appropriation is required.

**Fiscal Note Status:** The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

**Summary of Legislation**

This bill amends or repeals obsolete, unclear, or conflicting laws. The bill also clarifies statutory language, but does not change the intent or meaning of these sections of law. The appendix of the bill explains the reasons for each change.

**Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

The bill makes technical changes to laws that do not impact the revenues, expenditures, or workload of any state agency or local government. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

**Effective Date**

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature, with the following exceptions: Section 10 takes effect if both Senate Bill 21-092 and 21-147 becomes law on September 1, 2021, Section 15 takes effect if Senate Bill 21-059 becomes law on October, 2021, and Section 16 takes effect if Senate Bill 21-059 becomes law on October 1, 2021.
