2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-2-304, repeal (6)
3	as follows:
4	22-2-304. Education data advisory committee - creation -
5	duties. (6) (a) This section is repealed, effective July 1, 2022.
6	(b) Prior to such repeal, the EDAC shall be reviewed as provided
7	in section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.
8	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal
9	(12.5) as follows:
10	2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative
11	declaration - definition - repeal. (12.5) (a) The following statutory
12	authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on July
13	1, 2022:
14	(I) The education data advisory committee created pursuant to
15	section 22-2-304.
16	(b) This subsection (12.5) is repealed, effective July 1, 2023.
17	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
18	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
