A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE EXTENSION OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT, PUBLIC**
102 **SAFETY, AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SHARING GRANT**

Bill Summary

The law enforcement, public safety, and criminal justice information sharing grant program provides grants to assist local law enforcement agencies in gaining access to the information sharing system created in the Colorado information sharing consortium (CISC). Grant recipients can use the money to pay for computer hardware, software, and

programming costs necessary to connect to the CISC's information sharing systems. Currently, there is approximately \$185,000 remaining in the fund. There are multiple law enforcement agencies that need additional time to join the CISC because their budget timelines differ from the state budget timeline.

The bill extends the deadline for using money allocated to the law enforcement, public safety, and criminal justice information sharing grant program fund from June 30, 2022, to June 30, 2023, to allow those law enforcement agencies enough time to join the CISC and use the fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1617,
3 **amend** (5)(d) and (7) as follows:

4 **24-33.5-1617. Law enforcement, public safety, and criminal**
5 **justice information sharing grant program - rules - fund created -**
6 **definitions - repeal.** (5) **Law enforcement, public safety, and criminal**
7 **justice information sharing grant program fund.** (d) The state
8 treasurer shall transfer all unexpended and unencumbered money in the
9 fund on ~~July 1, 2022~~ JULY 1, 2023, to the general fund.

10 (7) **Repeal.** This section is repealed, effective ~~July 1, 2022~~ JULY
11 2, 2023.

12 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
13 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
14 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
