3 That in the Rules of the House of Representatives, Rule No. 54,
4 **amend** (a) as follows:

5 **54. Regulations for Remote Testimony in Committees**

6 (a) Pursuant to section 2-2-404 (2), C.R.S., this rule authorizes the
7 Speaker to promulgate regulations to enable government officials
8 and employees as well as other members of the public to testify
9 remotely in legislative proceedings of House committees of

12 regulations promulgated pursuant to this rule 54 prohibits
13 government officials or employees or other members of the public
