### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that: (1) reduces an appropriation to the Department of Higher Education for FY 2020-21 by \$13,050,000 cash funds from the Workers, Employers, and Workforce Centers Cash Fund, from amounts originating as federal Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Funds (ARPA Funds); and (2) provides an appropriation to the Department of Higher Education for FY 2021-22 of \$13,050,000 cash funds from the same source and authorizes unspent funds to be rolled forward for expenditure through FY 2023-24.
