Bill Topic: NONSUBSTANTIVE CHANGES TO TITLE 7 OF CRS

Summary of Fiscal Impact: **No fiscal impact.** The bill makes nonsubstantive changes to Title 7 of the Colorado Revised Statutes, which concerns corporations and associations. It does not impact the revenue or expenditures of any state or local agency, and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.

Summary of Legislation

The bill makes nonsubstantive changes to Title 7 of the Colorado Revised Statutes. It changes references to “owners’ interest” to “owner’s interest”, repeals obsolete provisions, and clarifies notification requirements of defective corporate actions to shareholders.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill does not change the revenue or expenditures of any state or local government agency, and thus is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 7, 2022, and takes effect August 9, 2022, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
