The bill replaces the term “criminal history” with “judicial” regarding name-based record checks in statute. It increases state workload starting in FY 2022-23.

## Summary of Legislation

The bill replaces the term “name-based criminal history record check” with “name-based judicial record check” in statute.

## State Expenditures

The bill may increase workload in the Judicial Department and the Department of Public Safety to respond to questions regarding the new terminology starting in FY 2022-23. The fiscal note assumes this workload can be accomplished within existing appropriations.

## Effective Date

This bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on April 21, 2022.
