Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides \$751,649 cash funds from the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund to the Department of Transportation for FY 2022-23.

Points to Consider

Marijuana Tax Cash Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2022-23 based on the March 2022 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package leaves approximately \$4.7 million available for appropriation or transfer from the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund for FY 2022-23, based on that revenue forecast. This bill will requires an appropriation \$751,649 from the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund for FY 2022-23, reducing the anticipated balance by the same amount.
