The bill would have removed the limitation to only biological substances on the naturopathic prescription drug formulary, and clarifies that the formulary may contain certain prescription substances or devices. It would have increased state workload in FY 2022-23.

**Appropriation Summary:** No appropriation would have been required.

**Fiscal Note Status:** The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill. This bill was not enacted into law; therefore, the impacts identified in this analysis do not take effect.

---

## Summary of Legislation

Under current law, naturopathic formulary additions are limited to biological substances, including vitamins, minerals, nutritive substances, and extracts. This bill removes the limitations and clarifies that the formulary may contain certain prescription substances and devices.

## State Expenditures

This bill will increase workload the Division of Professions and Occupations in the Department of Regulatory Agencies to conduct outreach to naturopaths about the change to the formulary. The division may also have an increase in rulemaking activities related to naturopathic formulary changes. These increases can be accomplished within existing appropriations.

## Effective Date

The bill was postponed indefinitely by the House Health and Insurance Committee on May 2, 2022.
