	The bill requires an institution of higher education to permit a veteran to audit a course for no credit if there is space available. Beginning in FY 2022-23, state revenue and expenditures may increase on an ongoing basis.

### **Summary of Legislation**

The bill requires an institution of higher education to permit a veteran to audit courses for no credit if space is available. Schools may charge a fee of no more than \$10 per audited course.

## **State Revenue and Expenditures**

Institutions of higher education may incur costs to update course audit policies to allow veterans space in classes. The institutions may charge a fee, increasing state revenue. This revenue is not subject to TABOR.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
