technical changes.

Summary of Legislation

This bill amends or repeals obsolete, unclear, or conflicting laws. The bill also clarifies statutory language, but does not change the intent or meaning of these sections of law. The appendix of the bill explains the reasons for each change.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill makes technical changes to laws that do not impact the revenue, expenditures, or workload of any state agency or local government. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on June 7, 2022, and it took effect on August 9, 2022, except that Section 31 takes effect only if HB 22-1278 does not become law, Section 86 takes effect only if HB 22-1242 does not become law, Section 99 takes effect only if HB 22-1040 becomes law, Section 100 takes effect only if HB 22-1211 becomes law, Section 103 takes effect only if HB 22-1098 becomes law, and Section 104 takes effect only if HB 22-1337.
