AN ACT

CONCERNING EXTENDING THE DATE BY WHICH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE POLICY AND FINANCING SHALL ADMINISTER THE REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH-CARE PROGRAM FROM JANUARY 1, 2022, TO JULY 1, 2022.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25.5-2-103, **amend** (2) as follows:

25.5-2-103. Reproductive health-care program - report - rules - definitions.

(2) On and after ~~January 1, 2022~~ JULY 1, 2022, the state department shall administer a reproductive health-care program, referred to in this section as the "program", that provides contraceptive methods and counseling services to participants.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
