A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING FUNDING FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES.

Bill Summary

**Legislative Interim Committee on School Finance.** The bill increases the required annual appropriation to the department of education by an additional \$40,203,671 to fund children who have one or more disabilities and receive special education services from a school district, board of cooperative services, a charter school network, a charter school collaborative, or the state charter school institute that is providing educational services to exceptional children.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-20-114, **add**  
3 (1)(c)(III)(B.2) as follows:

4           **22-20-114. Funding of programs - legislative declaration -**  
5 **repeal.** (1) Subject to the provisions of subsection (3) of this section, for  
6 the 2005-06 budget year and each budget year thereafter, the total amount  
7 appropriated to the department for the payment of costs incurred by  
8 administrative units for the provision of special education programs must  
9 be distributed to each administrative unit that provides educational  
10 services for children with disabilities as follows:

11           (c) (III) (B.2) EXCEPT AS SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (1.3) OF THIS  
12 SECTION, FOR THE 2023-24 BUDGET YEAR AND EACH BUDGET YEAR  
13 THEREAFTER, IN ADDITION TO ANY AMOUNT THAT IS AVAILABLE PURSUANT  
14 TO SUBSECTIONS (1)(c)(I), (1)(c)(III)(A), (1)(c)(III)(B), AND  
15 (1)(c)(III)(B.1) OF THIS SECTION, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL  
16 APPROPRIATE FORTY MILLION TWO HUNDRED THREE THOUSAND SIX  
17 HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE DOLLARS, WHICH AMOUNT MAY BE  
18 APPROPRIATED FROM THE STATE EDUCATION FUND CREATED IN SECTION  
19 17(4) OF ARTICLE IX OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION OR THE GENERAL FUND,  
20 OR AS AMOUNTS FROM BOTH FUNDS, TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE  
21 PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION (1)(c).

22           **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
23 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
24 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
