# A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND GIFTS, GRANTS,

#### **Bill Summary**

Currently, the division of veterans affairs (division) is authorized to accept gifts, grants, contributions, and donations to the western slope military veterans' cemetery fund, but is not authorized to expend such gifts, grants, contributions, or donations. **Section 1** of the bill gives the division such authority to expend.

Current law also allows certain programs housed within the department of public safety (department) to accept and expend gifts, grants, and donations for each program's specific purpose. However, the department does not have authority to accept or expend gifts, grants, or donations generally. **Section 2** authorizes the department to accept and expend gifts, grants, and donations for the purposes of the department and creates the department of public safety gifts, grants, and donations fund. The bill does not affect existing programs within the department that are authorized to accept and expend gifts, grants, and donations for their specific purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

3 (1)(a) as follows:

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28-5-708. Western slope veterans' cemetery - fund - rules.
(1) (a) There is hereby established in the state treasury the western slope military veterans' cemetery fund, referred to in this section as the "fund". The division is authorized to accept AND EXPEND gifts, grants, contributions, and donations for the purposes of this section. The fund

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 28-5-708, amend

9 shall consist of such moneys received through gifts, grants, contributions, 10 or donations, from any person or entity, and any moneys appropriated to 11 the fund by the general assembly. Any interest derived from the deposit 12 and investment of moneys in the fund shall be credited to the fund. At the 13 end of any fiscal year, all unexpended and unencumbered moneys in the 14 fund shall remain therein and shall not be credited or transferred to the 15 general fund or any other fund. SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 24-33.5-118 as
 follows:

3 24-33.5-118. Department of public safety gifts, grants, and 4 donations fund. THE DEPARTMENT MAY SEEK, ACCEPT, AND EXPEND 5 GIFTS, GRANTS, OR DONATIONS FROM PRIVATE OR PUBLIC SOURCES FOR 6 THE PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE 33.5. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSMIT 7 ALL MONEY RECEIVED THROUGH GIFTS, GRANTS, OR DONATIONS TO THE 8 STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE MONEY NOT OTHERWISE 9 REQUIRED TO BE CREDITED TO A SPECIFIC PROGRAM FUND CREATED IN THIS 10 ARTICLE 33.5 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY GIFTS, GRANTS, AND 11 DONATIONS FUND, WHICH FUND IS HEREBY CREATED AND REFERRED TO IN 12 THIS SECTION AS THE "FUND". THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT ALL 13 INTEREST AND INCOME DERIVED FROM THE DEPOSIT AND INVESTMENT OF 14 MONEY IN THE FUND TO THE FUND. SUBJECT TO ANNUAL APPROPRIATION 15 BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE DEPARTMENT MAY EXPEND ANY MONEY 16 FROM THE FUND FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE 33.5. MONEY 17 RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS 18 OF PART 13 OF ARTICLE 75 OF THIS TITLE 24.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.

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
