# A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING ADOPTING FEDERAL REGULATIONS TO THE "INDIAN CHILD WELFARE ACT OF 1978" AS STATE LAW.

## **Bill Summary**

The bill adopts federal regulations concerning the "Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978" as state law so that Colorado will continue to ensure that Indian children are protected in cases of guardianship and adoption.

6	court shall ensure compliance with The requirements of the federal
7	"Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978", 25 U.S.C. sec. 1901 et seq., IN
8	EFFECT AS OF FEBRUARY 9, 2003, AND THE RELATED REGULATIONS
9	LOCATED AT 25 CFR 23, IN EFFECT AS OF FEBRUARY 9, 2023, ARE
10	INCORPORATED INTO AND ADOPTED AS STATE LAW.
11	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds
12	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
13	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
