32 *The Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of
33 Representatives are authorized to hire Legislative Aides pursuant to Joint
34 Rule 39 of the House of Representatives and the Senate. If Legislative
35 Aides are authorized by the Executive Committee, acting in accordance
36 with such Joint Rule 39, to start prior to the convening of the next regular
37 session, they may be paid at the rate specified in this resolution from the
38 date they are authorized to start.

1 (2) That the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House
2 of Representatives remain in such capacity after adjournment of the
3 General Assembly *sine die* until the convening of the Second Regular
4 Session of the Seventy-fourth General Assembly in January, 2024.

5 (3) That the President of the Senate and the Chair of the House
6 Services Committee, with the authorization of the Speaker of the House
7 of Representatives, are hereby separately authorized to retain and hire
8 replacements for such employees for such period of time in the interim
9 between the First Regular Session of the Seventy-fourth General
10 Assembly and the Second Regular Session of the Seventy-fourth General
11 Assembly as they deem necessary for their respective houses; except that
12 the office equipment of the General Assembly and the services of such
13 employees may be used only in connection with official legislative
14 business.

15 (4) That the President of the Senate and the Chair of the House
16 Services Committee, with the authorization of the Speaker of the House
17 of Representatives, are hereby separately authorized to hire such
18 session-only employees for the next regular session as they deem
19 necessary for their respective houses and who may start their employment
20 on the date authorized.
