### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$14,737 General Fund to the Colorado Energy Office in the Office of the Governor for FY

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2023-24, and stating that the appropriation to the Office will require an additional 0.1 FTE.

## **Points to Consider**

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) is developing a budget package for FY 2023-24. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$14,737 for FY 2023-24, reducing the General Fund available for other FY 2023-24 appropriations by this amount.
