It would have increased state workload beginning in the current FY 2022-23. **Appropriation** No appropriation was required. **Summary:** The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill. The bill was postponed indefinitely by the **Fiscal Note** Status: House Health and Insurance Committee on February 17, 2023; therefore, the impacts identified in this analysis do not take effect.

Summary of Legislation

The bill requires a health-care provider performing an abortion of a fetus at 20-weeks gestational age or more to administer a painkiller to the fetus prior to the abortion with certain exceptions.

State Expenditures

This bill minimally increases workload in the Department of Regulatory Agencies to perform outreach and education through the medical and nursing boards in the Division of Professions and Occupations. No change in appropriations is required.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
