Summary of Fiscal Impact:

No fiscal impact. The bill clarifies that a powersports vehicle dealer may conduct certain activities away from the dealer's principal place of business. The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.

### **Summary of Legislation**

Under current law, a powersports vehicle dealer must maintain a principal place of business in the state. This bill clarifies that it is not a violation of this requirement when a dealer:

- delivers a powersports vehicle to customer, including for a test drive; or
- delivers documents to or obtains documents from a customer.

## Background

Motor vehicle and powersports manufacturers are regulated by the executive director of the Department of Revenue (DOR) and dealers are regulated by the Colorado Motor Vehicle Dealer Board via administration by the Auto Industry Division of the DOR.

## **Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

The bill clarifies existing statute and does not substantively change procedures or the number of violations handled in the DOR. The bill will not change the revenue, workload or expenditures of any state or local government. For these reasons, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
