purchase a Firehawk helicopter outright. The Colorado Firefighting Air Corps Fund is continuously appropriated to the Department of Public Safety.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2023-24 based on the March 2023 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2023-24 budget package the \$26.0 million General Fund revenue decrease that would result from the passage of this bill.

The first year of personnel and operating costs associated with the helicopter are included in the FY 2023-24 Long Bill and are intended to be supported by existing cash fund resources in the Colorado Firefighting Air Corps Fund.
