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CORRECT ERRONEOUS PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION END DATE

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

Bill Topic:

No fiscal impact. The bill corrects the end date for the property tax exemption for agricultural equipment used in a controlled environment agricultural facility. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

The fiscal note reflects the enacted bill. The bill was recommended by the Statutory

Revision Committee.

Summary of Legislation

House Bill 22-1301 stated that agricultural equipment used in a controlled environment agricultural facility is exempt from property tax prior to January 2, 2028. To align with the intent that the exemption be available for five property tax years, this bill corrects the end date to January 1, 2028.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. The fiscal note for HB 22-1301 assumed that the property tax exemption for agricultural equipment in a controlled environment agricultural facility would be in place for five years, through the 2027 property tax year. Correcting the end date from January 2, 2028 to January 1, 2028 does not change the estimated impacts of HB 22-1301, nor does it change revenue, expenditures, or workload for any state or local government agency.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on May 12, 2023, and takes effect on August 7, 2023, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
