A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING REMUNERATION-EXEMPT IDENTIFYING PLACARDS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at <http://leg.colorado.gov>.)

Current law exempts an individual with a remuneration-exempt identifying placard from paying at a parking device. The bill defines "parking device" as a single- or multi-space meter, kiosk, pay station, pay-by-space, pay-by-plate, pay-by-card, or other payment system or methodology for the parking of vehicles.

The bill also:

- Clarifies that a remuneration-exempt parking placard does not count toward the limits on the number of disability

- identifying placards and license plates the department of revenue (department) may issue to an individual;
- Increases the number of remuneration-exempt placards that the department may issue to an individual from one placard to 2 placards; and
- Specifies that an individual with a placard is exempt from paying at a parking device within a parking lot.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-204, **amend**
3 (3)(b)(I)(B); and **add** (1)(g.5) as follows:

4 **42-3-204. Reserved parking for persons with disabilities -**
5 **applicability - definitions - rules. (1) Definitions.** As used in this
6 section:

7 (g.5) "PARKING DEVICE" MEANS A SINGLE- OR MULTI-SPACE
8 METER, KIOSK, PAY STATION, PAY-BY-SPACE, PAY-BY-PLATE,
9 PAY-BY-CARD, OR OTHER PAYMENT SYSTEM OR METHODOLOGY FOR THE
10 PARKING OF VEHICLES.

11 (3) **Types of plates or placards. (b) Number of placards and**
12 **license plates allowed. (I) (B)** The department may issue ~~one~~ TWO
13 remuneration-exempt identifying ~~placard~~ PLACARDS to an eligible
14 individual. A REMUNERATION-EXEMPT IDENTIFYING PLACARD DOES NOT
15 COUNT TOWARD THE LIMITS ON PLACARDS AND PLATES SPECIFIED IN
16 SUBSECTION (3)(b)(I)(A) OF THIS SECTION.

17 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-4-1212, **amend**
18 (1) as follows:

19 **42-4-1212. Pay parking access for persons with disabilities.**
20 (1) A person who owns, operates, or manages a parking space,
21 INCLUDING A PARKING SPACE WITHIN A PARKING LOT, that requires
22 remuneration PAID THROUGH A PARKING DEVICE shall not tow, boot, or

1 otherwise take adverse action against an individual or motor vehicle
2 parking in the space for failure to pay the remuneration if the motor
3 vehicle bears a remuneration-exempt identifying placard issued pursuant
4 to section 42-3-204.

5 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
6 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
7 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
8 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
9 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
10 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
11 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
12 November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
13 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
