SENATE BILL 24-086

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A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER PREVENTION AND

102 TREATMENT FUND.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. For the 2024-25 state fiscal year, the bill transfers \$500,000 from the breast and cervical cancer prevention and treatment fund to the breast cancer screening fund. The bill also removes a requirement that the state treasurer transfer interest and income earned on money in the breast and cervical cancer prevention and treatment fund to the disability support fund.





1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-4-1503, amend
3 (1) as follows:

4 **25-4-1503.** Fund created. (1) There is hereby established in the 5 state treasury a fund to be known as the breast cancer screening fund, 6 which shall be IS subject to annual appropriation to the department for the 7 purposes of this part 15. The fund shall be credited with such 8 appropriations as the general assembly may make from the general fund 9 for the purposes of this part 15, as well as any moneys MONEY received 10 by the department pursuant to section 25-4-1505 (2) and (4), AND MONEY 11 TRANSFERRED TO THE FUND PURSUANT TO SECTION 25.5-5-308 (9)(h). In 12 accordance with section 24-36-114, C.R.S., all interest derived from the 13 deposit and investment of this THE fund shall be IS credited to the general 14 fund.

15 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25.5-5-308, amend
16 (8)(a)(I); repeal (8)(b.5); and add (9)(h) as follows:

17 25.5-5-308. Breast and cervical cancer prevention and 18 treatment program - creation - legislative declaration - definitions funds - repeal. (8) (a) (I) There is hereby created in the state treasury the 19 20 breast and cervical cancer prevention and treatment fund, referred to in 21 this subsection (8) as the "fund". The fund shall consist of any moneys 22 credited thereto CONSISTS OF MONEY CREDITED TO THE FUND pursuant to 23 section 24-22-115 (1); C.R.S., any gifts, grants, and donations; any 24 moneys MONEY appropriated thereto OR TRANSFERRED TO THE FUND by 25 the general assembly; and moneys credited thereto MONEY CREDITED TO 26 THE FUND pursuant to section 42-3-217.5 (3)(c). C.R.S. Except as 1 provided for in paragraph (b.5) of this subsection (8), All moneys MONEY 2 credited to the fund and all interest and income earned on the moneys 3 MONEY in the fund shall remain REMAINS in the fund for the purposes set 4 forth in this section. Any unexpended and unencumbered moneys MONEY 5 remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall remain REMAINS in 6 the fund and shall not be credited or transferred to the general fund or 7 another fund. The state department is encouraged to secure private gifts, 8 grants, and donations to fund the state costs of the breast and cervical 9 cancer prevention and treatment program.

(b.5) Until section 24-30-2204.5 is repealed, the state treasurer
 shall transfer any interest or income earned on moneys in the fund to the
 disability support fund, created in section 24-30-2205.5.

(9) (h) For the 2024-25, 2025-26, and 2026-27 state fiscal
YEARS, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER FIVE HUNDRED
THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM THE FUND TO THE BREAST CANCER SCREENING
FUND CREATED IN SECTION 25-4-1503.

SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-30-2205.5,
amend (1) as follows:

19 24-30-2205.5. Disability support fund. (1) There is hereby 20 created in the state treasury the disability support fund, which shall 21 consist CONSISTS of money transferred to the fund in accordance with 22 section 25.5-5-308 (8), C.R.S., from the sale of registration numbers 23 under this part 22, any money that may be appropriated to the fund by the 24 general assembly and any gifts, grants, or donations received by the 25 department of personnel for the purpose of implementing this part 22.

26 **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds, 27 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate

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- 1 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for
- 2 the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state
- 3 institutions.
