A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING JUDICIAL REVIEW OF A LOCAL LAND USE DECISION.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://leg.colorado.gov.)

The bill requires a court to award reasonable attorney fees to a prevailing defendant in an action for judicial review of a local land use decision, except for an action brought by the land use applicant before the governmental entity. Filing an action for judicial review of a local land use decision does not affect the validity of the local land use decision. The bill authorizes a governmental entity and the public to rely on the local land use decision in good faith for all purposes until the action for judicial review is resolved.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 13-51.5-104 as
3	follows:
4	13-51.5-104. Request for judicial review of local land use
5	decisions - attorney fees - effect of filing action - good-faith reliance.
6	(1) (a) The court shall award reasonable attorney fees to a
7	PREVAILING DEFENDANT IN ANY ACTION FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW OF A LOCAL
8	LAND USE DECISION BROUGHT PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE 51.5 OR RULE
9	106 (a)(4) OF THE COLORADO RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE.
10	(b) This subsection (1) does not apply to an action for
11	JUDICIAL REVIEW BROUGHT BY THE LAND USE APPLICANT BEFORE THE
12	GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY.
13	(2) FILING AN ACTION FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW OF A LOCAL LAND USE
14	DECISION PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE 51.5 OR RULE 106 (a)(4) OF THE
15	COLORADO RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE DOES NOT AFFECT THE VALIDITY
16	OF THE LOCAL LAND USE DECISION. THE GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY AND
17	PUBLIC MAY RELY ON THE LOCAL LAND USE DECISION IN GOOD FAITH FOR
18	ALL PURPOSES UNTIL THE ACTION FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW IS RESOLVED.
19	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly finds,
20	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
21	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for
22	the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state
23	institutions.
