A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE COLORADO NATURAL AREAS
102	COUNCIL, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, IMPLEMENTING
103	THE RECOMMENDATION IN THE 2023 SUNSET REPORT BY THE
104	DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY AGENCIES.

Bill Summary

Sunset Process - House Agriculture, Water and Natural Resources Committee. The bill implements the recommendation of the department of regulatory agencies, as specified in the department's sunset review of the regulation of the Colorado natural areas council, an advisory council to the parks and wildlife commission. The council is scheduled to repeal on September 1, 2024, but the bill continues the council indefinitely.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal
3	(15)(a)(II) as follows:
4	2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative
5	declaration - definition - repeal. (15) (a) The following statutory
6	authorizations for the designated advisory committees are scheduled for
7	repeal on September 1, 2024:
8	(II) The Colorado natural areas council, an advisory council to the
9	parks and wildlife commission, created in section 33-33-106, C.R.S.;
10	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, repeal 33-33-113 as
11	follows:
12	33-33-113. Legislative review - termination. (1) The council
13	terminates on September 1, 2024, unless the general assembly votes to
14	renew the legislative mandate of this article. Absent a vote to renew the
15	legislative mandate of this article, the council shall cease all operations
16	within a twelve-month period after September 1, 2024.
17	(2) Prior to the termination, the department of regulatory agencies
18	shall review the advisory committee as provided for in section 2-3-1203,
19	C.R.S.
20	SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
21	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
22	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
23	that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V

of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
