#### **Bill Summary**

Sunset Process - House Agriculture, Water, and Natural Resources Committee. The Colorado fire commission (commission) was created in the division of fire prevention and control in the department of public safety. The commission is set to be repealed, effective September 1, 2024, and is subject to a sunset review prior to its repeal. The bill implements the recommendations in the department of regulatory agencies' 2023 sunset report to continue the commission indefinitely.

**SECTION 4.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 4 5 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 6 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 7 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V 8 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 9 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 10 11 November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor. 12
