Bill Summary

Sunset Process - House Judiciary Committee. The bill

implements the recommendation of the department of regulatory agencies in its sunset review of the human trafficking council by continuing the council indefinitely.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal 3 (15)(a)(VIII) as follows: 4 2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative 5 **declaration - definition - repeal.** (15) (a) The following statutory 6 authorizations for the designated advisory committees are scheduled for 7 repeal on September 1, 2024: 8 (VIII) The Colorado human trafficking council created in section 9 18-3-505; 10 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-3-505, repeal (6) 11 as follows: 12 Human trafficking council - created - duties. 18-3-505. 13 (6) This section is repealed, effective September 1, 2024. Before repeal, 14 the department of regulatory agencies shall review the council pursuant 15 to section 2-3-1203. 16 **SECTION 3.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 17 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 18 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 19 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V 20 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 21 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take 22 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in

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- November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
- 2 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
