# **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

#### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$280,928 General Fund to the Department of Early Childhood for FY 2024-25. This

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provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 2.7 FTE.

### **Points to Consider**

#### General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2024-25 based on the March 2024 Office of State Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) revenue forecast. The budget package includes \$93.5 million in set-asides for legislation outside of the package (see table below). The budget package accounts for the 15.0 percent reserve associated with the placeholders (a total of \$14.0 million).

This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$280,928 for FY 2024-25, reducing the \$93.5 million set aside by the same amount.
