Future Fiscal Impact

Although this bill would not require a General Fund appropriation for FY 2024-25, it is projected to require General Fund appropriations of \$714,320 in FY 2025-26 and \$186,660 in FY 2026-27 and years thereafter. Additionally, the bill is estimated to reduce cash funds revenue by \$57,749 for FY 2025-26, reducing the TABOR refund for that year by the same amount.
