J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$200,000 General Fund to the Department of Higher Education for FY 2024-25.

Bill Sponsor amendment L.004 (attached) reduces the additional appropriation required for

the Teacher Mentor Grant program beginning in FY 2024-25 from \$200,000 to \$100,000 General Fund. Bill Sponsor amendment **J.002** (attached) provides an appropriation of \$100,000 General Fund to the Department of Higher Education for FY 2024-25.

The Committee may adopt J.001 OR the combination of L.004 and J.002.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2024-25 based on the March 2024 Office of State Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) revenue forecast. The budget package includes \$63.1 million in set-asides for legislation outside of the package (see table below). The budget package accounts for the 15.0 percent reserve associated with the placeholders (a total of \$9.5 million).

This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$200,000 (if **J.001** is adopted) or \$100,000 (if **L.004** and **J.002** are adopted) for FY 2024-25, reducing the \$63.1 million set aside by the same amount.
