*General Fund Impact*

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2024-25 based on the March 2024 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2024-25 budget package the \$31,160,000 General Fund revenue increase that would result from the passage of this bill.
