General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2024-25 based on the March 2024 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2024-25 budget package the \$231.7 million General Fund, and \$500,0000 General Fund Exempt, revenue decrease that would result from the passage of this bill, which includes the General Fund impact of adopting amendment **L.009**.
