Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates a total of \$36,679 General Fund to the Legislative Department for FY 2024-25. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.3 FTE.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

L.028 Bill Sponsor amendment **L.028** (attached) clarifies that two members of the Regional Transportation District Governance Subcommittee appointed by the Joint Transportation Committees shall also be members representing a local government.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2024-25 based on the March 2024 Office of State Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) revenue forecast. The budget package includes \$63.1 million in set-asides for legislation outside of the package (see table below). The budget package accounts for the 15.0 percent reserve associated with the placeholders (a total of \$9.5 million).
