#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides an appropriation of \$1,477,127 General Fund to the Department of Public Safety for FY 2024-25. This includes \$1,430,424 for use by the Colorado Bureau of Investigation, which amount is based on an assumption that the Bureau will require an additional 10.1 FTE. It also includes \$46,703 for use by the Department's Executive

# General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2024-25 based on the March 2024 Office of State Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) revenue forecast. The budget package includes \$93.5 million in set-asides for legislation outside of the package (see table below). The budget package accounts for the 15.0 percent reserve associated with the placeholders (a total of \$14.0 million).

This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$1,477,127 for FY 2024-25, reducing the \$93.5 million set aside by the same amount.
