Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$1,690,258 General Fund to the Department of Public Safety and includes an assumption that the Department requires an additional 10.1 FTE. However, the appropriation does not conform with JBC or Legislative Council Staff fiscal note policies by including centrally appropriated costs for the first year. Amendment J.001 includes

a corrected appropriation consistent with fiscal note policies.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to change the existing clause to appropriate a total of \$1,477,127 General Fund to the Department of Public Safety for FY 2024-25. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 10.1 FTE.

Points to Consider

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) is developing a budget package for FY 2024-25. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$1,477,127 for FY 2024-25, reducing the General Fund available for other FY 2024-25 appropriations by this amount.
