Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates a total of \$154,287 General Fund for FY 2024-25, including \$124,287 for the Department of Higher Education and \$30,000 for the

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Department of Labor and Employment. The provision also states that the Department of Higher Education will require an additional 1.2 FTE.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2024-25 based on the March 2024 Office of State Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) revenue forecast. The budget package includes \$63.1 million in set-asides for legislation outside of the package (see table below). The budget package accounts for the 15.0 percent reserve associated with the placeholders (a total of \$9.5 million).
