Summary of Legislation

The bill transfers \$500,000 from the Breast and Cervical Cancer Prevention and Treatment Fund in the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing (HCPF) to the Breast Cancer Screening Fund in the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) annually from FY 2024-25 through FY 2026-27. The bill also removes a requirement that interest and income earned on money in the Breast and Cervical Cancer Prevention and Treatment Fund be transferred to the Disability Support Fund.

State Transfers

The bill transfers \$500,000 from the Breast and Cervical Cancer Prevention and Treatment Fund to the Breast Cancer Screening Fund in each of FY 2024-25 through FY 2026-27.

The bill also curtails the transfer of interest earnings from the Breast and Cervical Cancer Prevention and Treatment Fund to the Disability Support Fund in the Department of Personnel and Administration. The fiscal note assumes this transfer equated to \$78,000 per year.

State Expenditures

HCPF is currently not expending the full amount of the Breast and Cervical Cancer Prevention and Treatment Fund. Once the excess amount is transferred CDPHE will expend the funding on additional breast cancer screenings.

State Appropriations

For FY 2024-25, the bill includes an appropriation of \$500,000 from the Breast Cancer Screening Fund to the Department of Public Health and Environment.

Effective Date

This bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on June 5, 2024.
