Bill Topic: HEMP PRODUCT DEFINITION MARIJUANA REGULATION

Summary of Fiscal Impact: No fiscal impact. The bill updates statutory references of hemp product to conform with prior legislation. The bill has no impact on state revenue or expenditures.

Appropriation Summary:

The final fiscal note reflects the enacted bill, which was recommended by the Statutory Status: Revision Committee.

### **Summary of Legislation**

Senate Bill 23-271 changed the phrase "industrial hemp product" to "hemp product." The bill makes conforming changes by removing the word "industrial" where appropriate.

### **Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

Because the bill conforms definitions and references from previously passed legislation and does not change any state activities around marijuana and its regulation, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on May 1, 2024, and takes effect on August 7, 2024, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
