Appropriation Summary:	No appropriation was required.		
Fiscal Note Status:	The final fiscal note reflects the introduced bill. This bill was postponed indefinitely by the Senate Business, Labor, and Technology Committee on April 18, 2024; therefore, the impacts identified in this analysis do not take effect.		

# **Summary of Legislation**

The bill allows a procurement official to select the most appropriate source selection method, given time requirements, financial considerations, and market conditions, even when a source selection method is specified in statute.

#### **State Expenditures**

The bill may decrease state expenditures in any state agency beginning in FY 2024-25 if their procurement processes are adjusted to select sources that are more cost effective. Any cost savings will vary on a per-procurement basis and cannot be estimated.

# **Effective Date**

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
