BILL TOPIC: "Distribute Anvil Points Fund Money To Counties"

A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE STATE TREASURER**
102 **DISTRIBUTE ANY FEDERAL MINERAL LEASE REVENUE FROM THE**
103 **FEDERAL ANVIL POINTS FUND TO SPECIFIED COUNTIES.**

Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee. If the state receives any federal mineral lease revenue that has been held in the anvil points fund, then instead of depositing the money in the mineral leasing fund, the state treasurer is required to distribute the money as follows:

- 40% to Garfield county;

*Capital letters indicate new material to be added to existing statute.
Dashes through the words indicate deletions from existing statute.*

- 40% to Rio Blanco county;
- 10% to Mesa county; and
- 10% to Moffat county.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 34-63-104, **add** (3)
3 as follows:

4 **34-63-104. Special funds relating to oil shale lands.** (3) THE
5 STATE TREASURER SHALL DISTRIBUTE ALL OF THE MONEY THAT THE STATE
6 RECEIVES FROM THE UNITED STATES TREASURY OUT OF THE ANVIL POINTS
7 FUND AS FOLLOWS:

- 8 (a) FORTY PERCENT TO GARFIELD COUNTY;
- 9 (b) FORTY PERCENT TO RIO BLANCO COUNTY;
- 10 (c) TEN PERCENT TO MESA COUNTY; AND
- 11 (d) TEN PERCENT TO MOFFAT COUNTY.

12 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
13 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
14 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
