Attached are four tables that provide an overview of the General Fund as a result of the decisions made by the JBC during figure setting. These tables reflect:

- 1. **Table 1 General Fund Overview:** This table provides an overview of the current situation based on the JBC decisions as of March 17, 2008. Based on these decisions the General Fund is \$2.9 million over the 6 percent limit in FY 2007-08 and \$46.3 million over the 6 percent limit in FY 2008-09.
- 2. Table 2 Departmental Summary of FY 2006-07 and FY 2007-08 General Fund Appropriations and FY 2008-09 JBC Actions Prior to Introduction of Long Bill: This table provides a summary of General Fund requests, by department supplemental and figure setting decisions.
