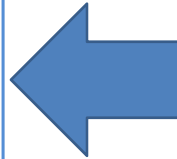

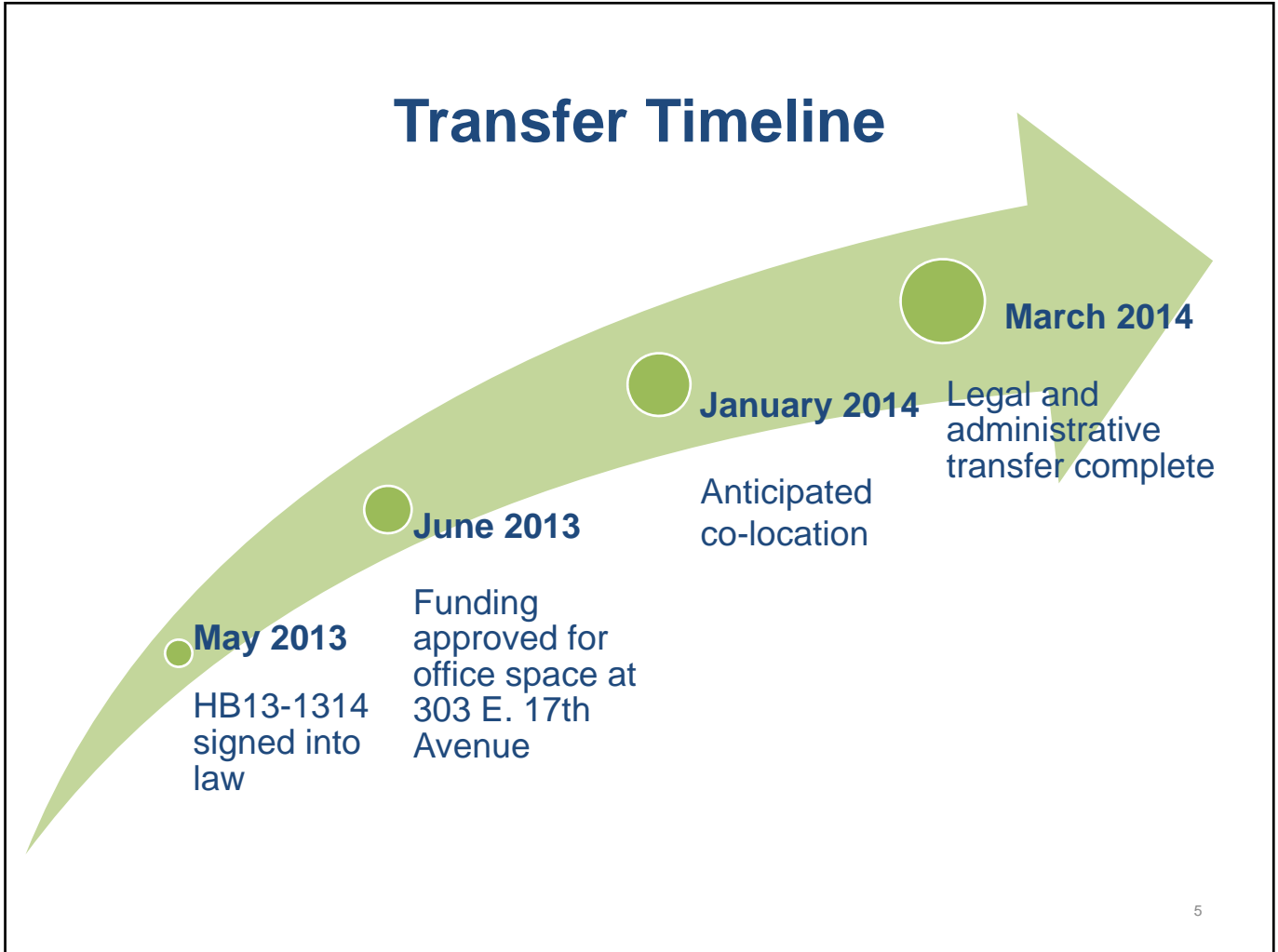
## Benefits
