- 3 Page 1, strike line 19 and substitute "IS BEING RECORDED.
  - (6) (a) The state department shall convene a working group to review the questions that are asked when a person calls in to the hotline system to report suspected child abuse or neglect. No later than November 15, 2023, the working group shall develop recommendations to standardize the questions as much as practicable. The working group consists of the following members:
- 11 (I) TWO MEMBERS WHO REPRESENT A COUNTY DEPARTMENT, ONE 12 FROM AN URBAN COUNTY AND ONE FROM A RURAL COUNTY;
  - (II) TWO MEMBERS WHO ARE COUNTY ATTORNEYS, ONE FROM AN URBAN COUNTY AND ONE FROM A RURAL COUNTY;
  - (III) THE HOTLINE SYSTEM COORDINATOR, OR THE COORDINATOR'S DESIGNEE;
    - (IV) ONE MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAM, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 26-7.5-102 (3);
    - (V) ONE MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS THE OFFICE OF RESPONDENT PARENTS' COUNSEL CREATED IN SECTION 13-92-103;
    - (VI) One member who represents the office of the child's representative created in section 13-91-104;
    - (VII) TWO MEMBERS WHO ARE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE ADVOCATES, ONE WHO REPRESENTS DISPROPORTIONATELY IMPACTED COMMUNITIES AND ONE WHO IS A STATEWIDE MEMBER;
      - (VIII) ONE MEMBER WHO IS A CHILD ABUSE ADVOCATE;
- 27 (IX) ONE MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS LAW ENFORCEMENT 28 AGENCIES; AND
  - (X) ONE MEMBER WHO REPRESENTS A NONPROFIT ASSOCIATION THAT ADVOCATES FOR CIVIL LIBERTIES.
- 31 (b) The working group may coordinate with other task 32 forces and working groups, as necessary, to discuss related 33 topics.".".

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
