Emily King, agriculture employer representative

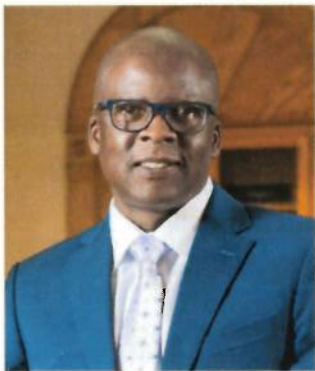
Emily King joined Pinnacol's board of directors in 2023.
