

**SB 20-081 School Information for Apprenticeship Directory**  
**SPONSORS: Senators Danielson, Bridges^Representatives Sullivan, Larson**  
**Assigned Committee: Education**

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**WHY WE NEED IT:**

In 2019, we established the state's first Apprenticeship Directory, which helps spread the word about the hundreds of apprenticeships available here in Colorado. Now that the directory is up and running, we identified a need to include school contact information so that apprenticeship programs can easily reach out to schools, and so that students know who to talk to for information about apprenticeships. This bill is a simple fix - adding contact information to the apprenticeship directory for every public school in the state.

**SUMMARY:**

- This bill will update the Dept. of Labor & Employment's Apprenticeship Program Directory to include a point of contact at every public school and school district in Colorado.
- CDLE will coordinate with the Dept. of Education to provide those contacts. The contacts could be a guidance counselor, teacher, or other school official appropriately designated for the task.
- The contact information will be at least a mailing address, e-mail address, phone number, and the school or district that contact represents.
