AMENDMENT 1 TO AMENDMENT C

Page 2, line 12, strike “permits workers to receive compensation up to the minimum wage.” and substitute “PERMITS PEOPLE MANAGING OR OPERATING CHARITABLE GAMES TO EITHER BE VOLUNTEERS OR TO RECEIVE COMPENSATION, SUCH AS MEALS OR PAYMENT, WHICH CANNOT EXCEED THE MINIMUM WAGE.”.

Page 3, line 22, after “holders.” insert “THE ADMINISTRATIVE FEES FROM NEW LICENSEES HELP OFFSET THE INCREASED STATE SPENDING.”.

Dear Legislative Council members and staff,

I am writing to suggest a clarification to page 2, line 12 which says [Amendment C] ..."permits workers to receive compensation up to the minimum wage."

Allowing workers of bingo and raffle games to receive compensation up to the minimum wage does not take away the option for nonprofits to rely solely on unpaid volunteers to operate games. Nor does it affect an individual's choice to be an unpaid volunteer to help run a bingo or raffle game.

I suggest changing this to "...permits workers to receive compensation up to the minimum wage if offered by the nonprofit organization." This should help reiterate that it's the nonprofit organization's choice to offer compensation and the worker's choice to work a game for compensation.
